### What Is the Truth about Geology and the Fossils?

#### Worldwide Flood - Not Gradual Formation

The Bible de clares that God cre ated the en tire universe and all of its con tents in six lit eral days about 6200 years ago. Biblical creationism studies these creation state ments in the Bible. Scientific creationism observes supporting evidences in the physical world for these state ments about creation. Exodus 20:11 For in six days the LORD made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that in them is.

Evolutionists arguethat small amounts of water(local floods) over large amounts of time (bil lions of years) produced the geo logic for mations of the earth. Creationists argue that a large amount of water (worldwide flood) in a short amount of time (year-long flood and aftereffects) produced the geological formations of the earth. Creationists in di cate that the large amount of water was ac tually a huge cataclysm of wa ter that cov ered the en tire earth in a year-long world wide flood in the days of Noah. This world wide flood oc curred about 4500 years ago and was fol lowed by a few thou sands of years of after effects form ing the major geo logic features of the earth's surface that we observe to day. 2 Pe ter 3:6 Whereby the world that then was, be ing over flowed with water, per ished.

An ever-increasing number of scientists in recent vears have declared their confidence in creationism. These scientists are convinced that scientific evidence is in 100% sup port of the lit eral ac count of cre ation in the Bible. Such sci en tists con sider evo lu tion to be a sci entific fairy tale just as the flat earth the ory was in the 12th century. 1 Tim o thy 6:20 ... keep that which is committed to thy trust, avoiding profane and vain babblings, and oppositions of sci ence falsely so called.

Cre ationists in di cate that lay ers of the geo log i cal column are evidences of the worldwide catastrophe of Noah's flood. The geologic column is mostly cat a strophically deposited sedimentary layers accompanied by some volcanic layers and in trusions. The geologic column was formed due to the following effects and after effects from the world wide flood of Noah: (1) various den si ties of ma terials settling from worldwide flood waters that sorted the sed i ments into lay ers; (2) var i ous water cur rents carrying different muds, rocks and materialsthat mixed in various orders and deposited their payloads in layers

other than by density; (3) tectonic activities that forced sediments into various lay ers through earth plate movements, earth quakes, and vol canic disruptions.

### What Is the Geologic Column?

### Worldwide Flood and Ecological Zoning -Not Evolution!

The geologic column is a better evidence for ecological zon ing than for evo lu tion. In ecological zoning, God placed living creatures on the earth in life zones for sur vival. For ex ample:

- (1) Mam mals (dogs, horses, el e phants, etc.) are zoned to live on the land at the high est levels of the earth.
- (2) In verte brates (amphibians, etc.) are zoned to live at the interface of water and land.
- (3) Marine ver te brates (fish, etc.) are zoned to live in the fluid lay ers above the bot tom of the seas.
- (4) Marine in verte brates (crabs, lob sters, bryo zoans, brachi o pods, etc.) are zoned to live in the low est part of the earth at the bot tom of the seas.

If there were to be a worldwide flood this year, the flood would bury living creatures into geo logic layers due to ecological zoning, not evolution. Likewise, the geologic lay ers and fos sils in the earth to day are evidences of ecological zoning in creation, not evolution. The fos sils bur ied in the earth to day are a re cord of the burial of different creatures that lived in different ecological zones before the worldwide flood of Noah.

Fos sils and the geo logic column of ten are found in reversed or mixed or der rather than the ex pected or der of ecological zoning. This reversal or mixing of fossils and the geo logic col umn is ex actly as ex pected due to tur bu lence and mixing effects from the worldwide flood of Noah. Fossils do not con tain ev i dence of one or gan ism evolving into a completely different kind of or gan ism. The fos sils bur ied in the earth are a re cord of world wide flood and eco log i cal zon ing but not evo lu tion!

### Evidences for Creation and World wide Flood in Ohio, In di ana and Illinois

The earth is covered with sedimentary deposits containing fossils that settled from the waters of Noah's Flood. This world wide flood cov ered the earth about 4500 years ago and bur ied all pre vi ous land life ex cept for the creatures saved in Noah's Ark. A gla cial ice age lasting about 600 to 900 years cov ered large por tions of the earth as an aftereffect from Noah's Flood. The freezing effectof the glacial period was observed even in the warm climates of the Middle East countries. Job 38:30 The waters are hid as with a stone, and the face of the deep is frozen.

The world wide flood of Noah bur ied the fos sils commonly found in South west ern Ohio. The ad vancing and sub siding ice age produced by the flood re moved the up persediments of the worldwide flood. This bulldozing ef fect formed the flat gla cial plains of Ohio con tain ing the ma rine in verte brate fos sils de posited from the lowest lay ers of the world wide flood sed i ments. The southernmost reaches of the glacier bulldozed flood sediments into huge moraines (glacial hills) found just southwest of Route 4 in Fairfield, Ohio. The Fairfield Community Building on Pleas ant Avenue is located at the base of a gla cial mo raine formed by the great gla cier that cov ered much of Ohio.

To day you can dig into your back yard and find fos sils formed by the world wide flood of Noah and its after effects in cluding the ice age. Al most all fos sils found will be varieties of sea creatures living in the oceans to day, although some fos sil ized crea tures have be come ex tinct.

The most com mon fos sils found in the back yards of Ohio, In di ana, and Illinois in clude the following:



Bryozoans (Greek for moss animals) are the most common fossils in southwestern Ohio. Bryozoans are tinycolonialorganisms

some times mistaken for cor als and live in the oceans to day. Bryozoan fos sils of ten look like tree twigs.

Brachiopods (Greek for arm foot) are shelled solitary marine organisms. They are the second most commonfossils in southwestern



Ohio. The left and right halves of the brachiopodshells are usu ally mir ror im ages of each other.

**Pelecypods** (Greek for *hatchet foot* ) are shelled ma rine or gan isms and in clude clams, scal lops, oys ters, and mus-





sels. Pelecypod fossils are the third most com mon fossils in southwestern Ohio. The two pelecypod shell haves are mir ror im ages of each other when held with the plane of sym me try passing be tween the two valves.



Gastropods (Greek for stomach foot) are snails. The gastropod shell is coiled in a con i cal or sin gle plane.

**Corals** (colony cor als and horn cor als) are solitary or colonial. Corals excrete a hard calcium carbonate

solitary cor als are large and horn shaped. Co lo nial coral fossils of ten have a honey comb shape.

Crinoids are marine animals having a long stalk or column. Crinoids are often called sealilies and a crinoid crown looks like an upside down star fish. A tiny star usually can be seen in the cross section of the cri noid col umn. The stalk column is the most common cri noid fos sil part found.





Cephalopods (Greek for *head foot*) include the squid, octopus, and nautiloids. The Cincinnatian nautiloid looks like an octopus with a dunce

hat shell. The fossil cephalopod is only the dunce hat shell portion of the nautiloid.

**Trilobites** (Greek for *three lobes*) include the Isotelus, an Ordovician trilobite that is *Ohio's official* 

state fos sil. Trilobites are similar to the horseshoe crab found in the oceans today. The common pillbug is similar to the tri lo bite. The trilobite fossil is more difficult to find.



### What Do the Fossils Really Teach Us? God Judges Sin!

Immediately after being created, Adam rebelled against God and be came corrupted in all the faculties of

In the 1656 years from cre ation to Noah's flood, man's sins (re-

bellion against God) increasingly polluted all that man con tacted. Be cause of this, God de stroyed man by means of a worldwide flood. Only Noah, his family, and the crea tures on Noah's huge ark were saved from the flood's destruction. Gen e sis 6:5 And GOD saw that the wick edness of man was great in the earth, and that ev ery imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually... 7 And the LORD said, I will destroy man whom I have cre ated from the face of the earth; both man, and beast, and the creeping thing, and the fowls of the air... 8 But Noah found grace in the eyes of the LORD.

The world wide flood of Noah, was the most sig nif i cant geo logic event that has ever oc curred on the earth since its creation. The only survivors of the flood were Noah, his three sons, and their wives. In addition, the totality of air-breathing an i mals in the world were de stroyed with the ex ception of those Di vinely protected in Noah's Ark. Land and sea creatures living before the worldwide flood of Noah were buried in sed i ments and vol canic matter forming the fos sils that are in the earth to day.

The fos sils teach us that God judges sin. The world-wide flood of Noah oc curred be cause man was wick edly sin ful and God judges sin. The fos sils are bur ied in the ground be cause God judges sin

The fos sils are re minders that we are all sin ners against the Holy God, and we all de serve to be pun ished. That punishment is separation from God forever in hell.
