- Christian dating is planned fellow ship with a member of the opposite sex.
 - A. Dating is to be Christian! Amos 3:3 Can two walk together, ex cept they be agreed? II Cor. 6:14 Be ye not un equally yoked to gether with un be lievers: for what fellow ship hath righteous ness with un righteous ness? and what com mu nion hath light with dark ness?
 - B. Dating helps the search for a pro spec tive spouse. Gen. 2:18 And the LORD God said, It is not good that the man should be alone; I will make him an help meet for him. Prov. 18:22 Whoso findeth a wife findeth a good thing, and obtaineth fa your of the LORD.
 - C. Dating affects others. Dating affects your family, friends, church, pas tor, and you. Don't date some one who would not be ap proved by your Chris tian friends, family, loved ones, church, and pas tor. Chris tians can help you! Ask them for ad vice!
 - 1. Christian parents have experienced the tribulations and joys of dating. Ask them for advice! Rom. 5:3-4 And not only so, but we glory in tribulations also: knowing that tribulation worketh patience; 4 And patience, experience; and experience, hope.
 - Christian parents are wiser than you. Certain wisdom comes only with age. Ask them for advice! Eph. 6:1 Children, obey your parents in the Lord: for this is right.
 - 3. Chris tian par ents are con cerned about your fu ture, and will see things that infatuation may blind you from see ing. Ask them for ad vice! Prov. 4:1 Hear, ye chil dren, the in struction of a father, and at tend to know under standing.
 - 4. Your church and pastor are provided by God to guide you. Ask them for ad vice! Eph. 4:11-12 And he [Je sus] gave some [churches], apostles; and some, prophets; and some, evangelists; and some, pastors and teachers; 12 For the perfecting of the saints, for the edifying of the body of Christ [the Lord's Church].
- II. De sir able Christian char ac ter is tics for you/your date.
 - A. Congeniality:the abil ity to get along with oth ers in a happy way. Rom. 12:13 ... given to hos pital ity.
 - B. Dependability: always be ready to do that which is right. The best ability is dependability! Isaiah 6:8 Also I[Isaiah] heard the voice of the Lord, saying, Whom shall I send, and who will go for us? Then said I, Here am I; send me.
 - C. Thoughtfulness: shows concern and understanding. Prov. 13:15 Good under standing giveth favour.
 - D. Neat ness and clean li ness of body and soul: your body re leases a quart of per spi ration each day and you must work to be neat and clean. Bac te ria live in your mouth and on your body: brush your teeth and use de odor ant.

- Isa iah 1:16 Wash you, make you clean; put away the evil of your do ings from be fore mine eyes; cease to do evil; Psalm 119:9 Wherewithal shall a young man cleanse his way? by tak ing heed thereto ac cord ing to thy word.
- E. Appearance: mod est with con sid er ation for the preferences of other Christians. Don't let gaudy apparel and make-up be come an over bear ing adorn ment that characterizes what you are. Remember, others are watch ing and copy ing you. I Tim. 2:9 In like man ner also, that women adorn them selves in mod est ap parel, with shame faced ness and so bri ety; not with broided hair, or gold, or pearls, or costly array. Romans 14:7 For none of us liveth to him self, and no man dieth to himself.
- F. Sportsmanship: play hard but fair with a pleas ant approach. Play to win, but pray for power to stand strong in Christ by showing good sports man ship. Prov. 4:23 Keep thy heart with all dil i gence; for out of it are the is sues of life.
- G. Habits: good home habits will produce good public habits. Be consider ate and help ful at home. Treat your family with respect and kindness. It is eas ier to prevent bad hab its than to break them! Proverbs 20:11 Even a child is known by his do ings, whether his work be pure, and whether it be right.
- H. Compliments: accept and give compliments simply and grace fully. Prov. 10:20 The tongue of the just is as choice silver: the heart of the wicked is little worth. Prov erbs 25:11 A word fitly spo ken is like ap ples of gold in pic tures of sil ver.
- I. Convictions: know the Bi ble and stand fast, un wa vering in the truth. Use the Bi ble as your guide for life. II Tim. 1:12-13 For the which cause I also suf fer these things: nevertheless I am not ashamed: for I know whom I have believed, and am persuaded that he is able to keep that which I have committed unto him against that day. 13 Hold fast the form of sound words, which thou hast heard of me, in faith and love which is in Christ Je sus.
- J. Your body: treat your body properly and rever ently. I Cor. 6:19-20 What? know ye not that your body is the tem ple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own? 20 For ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's.
- III. Good man ners for dating.
 - A. Introductions: introduce your friends to others, give honor to whom honor is due, show that you are happy to meet others, shake hands firmly. Romans 13:7 Render therefore to all their dues: tribute to whom trib ute is due; cus tom to whom cus tom; fear to whom fear; hon our to whom hon our.
 - B. Conversation: let your words and life speak clearly for Christ. Philippians 1:27 Only let your conversation be as it becometh the gospel of Christ: that whether I come and see you, or else be ab sent, I may hear of your

- af fairs, that ye stand fast in one spirit, with one mind striving to gether for the faith of the gos pel.
- C. Driving:obey the laws. I Pe ter 2:13-15 Sub mit yourselves to every or dinance of man for the Lord's sake: whether it be to the king, as su preme; 14 Or unto gover nors, as unto them that are sent by him for the punish ment of evil doers, and for the praise of them that do well. 15 For so is the will of God, that with well doing ye may put to si lence the ig no rance of fool ish men.
- D. Lan guage: do not use any swear/curse words, eu phemis tic swear/curse words, or use words that sound like curses or swear ing. Matt. 5:34-37 But I say unto you, Swear not at all; neither by heaven; for it is God's throne: 35 Nor by the earth; for it is his foot stool: neither by Je ru sa lem; for it is the city of the great King. 36 Neither shalt thou swear by thy head, because thou canst not make one hair white or black. 37 But let your communication be, Yea, yea; Nay, nay: for what soever is more than these com eth of evil.

IV. Date truly beau ti ful peo ple.

- A. True beauty and value are in holiness (sanctification). Ps. 29:2 Give unto the LORD the glory due unto his name; worship the LORD in the beauty of holiness.
- B. Without Christ, society will selfishly and viciously gratify it self at the expense of the in dividual.
 - I. Society exerts unrealistic social pressure with unreach able values that con sume. Ps 39:11 When thou [Lord] with re bukes dost correct man for in iquity, thou makest his beauty to consume away like a moth: surely every man is van ity. Selah.
 - 2. Date rape is a con stant threat in our so ci ety! Women are physically weaker and can be overpowered by men. Por nog raphy and un godly mu sic teach men to grab what they want. Men who ex pose them selves to such un godly in flu ences are dan ger ous and abusive to women. Tamar was a beautiful and godly young woman who was attacked and raped by her half-brother on a contrived date, II Sam. 13. Women must be care ful even with friends and relatives! Men must keep pure thoughts and actions. If any im proper ad vances are ever made, GET HELP from Christian par ents, pas tor, or other coun sel ors from your church!
- C. Beauty and value in our cul ture are im properly based on physical at tractive ness rather than a righteous and holyreverential fear of God. Prov. 31:30 Fa vour is deceit ful, and beauty is vain: but a woman that feareth the LORD, she shall be praised.
 - 1. Those who have phys i cal beauty will be ex ploited by society. A psychological study indicated more phys i cally at trac tive col lege girls were less hap pily mar ried 25 years later. Ps. 12:2 They speak van ity every one with his neighbour: with flattering lips and with a double heart do they speak. Jude 16....their mouth speaketh great swelling words, having men's per sons in ad miration be cause of ad-

vantage.

- a. Sarah al most lost her happy mar riage to Abraham because of attempts to exploit her beauty. She would have lost her husband and marriage had not God in ter vened. Gen. 12:11-20; Gen. 20.
- b. Attempts to exploit Rebekah's beauty caused Isaac to fear for his life at Gerar, Gen. 26.
- c. Jo seph lost his position as over seer in Potiphar's house due to a woman's attempt to exploit his beauty, Gen. 39.
- d. Bathsheba's beauty was exploited in adultery with King Da vid, II Sam. 11:2-4.
- 2. The aging process is more painful for the person caught in the physical beauty cult. Ecc. 12:1 Remem ber now thy Cre ator in the days of thy youth, while the evil days come not, nor the years draw nigh, when thou shalt say, I have no pleasure in them.
- D. Do not date oth ers based only on ap pear ance.
 - 1. Learn to apply God's standards. In selecting the new king of Is rael to re place Saul, Sam uel se lected the tall est, most hand some son of Jesse, but God told him other wise. I Sam. 16:7 But the LORD said unto Samuel, Look not on his countenance, or on the height of his stature; be cause I have re fused him: for the LORD seeth not as man seeth; for man looketh on the out ward ap pear ance, but the LORD looketh on the heart.
 - Je sus warned against look ing only to ap pear ances. John 7:24 Judge not according to the appearance, but judge righ teous judg ment.
- E. Don't choose your date using worldly beauty and self-value stan dards.
 - 1. Rock music and country music thrive on the beauty-and-lust cult. Avoid mod ern music deal ing with dating, broken hearts, drug usage, and luv-luv-luv with the focus upon beauty and lust. Psalm 68:32 Sing unto God, ye kingdoms of the earth; O sing praises unto the Lord; Selah.
 - 2. TV thrives on immorality based on the beauty-and-lust cult. Stop ungodly influence on your date. Psalm 119:37 Turn away mine eyes from be holding vanity; and quicken thou me in thy way.
- F. Put-downcom edy de stroys a proper un der stand ing of the build ing re la tion ships that should be in our fam i lies. Have a no put-down pol icy for all your dates. IThess. 5:11 Where fore com fort your selves to gether, and ed ify one an other, even as also ye do.
- V. Dating can re sult in last ing love. True love is giv ing of oneself to another. Love produces emotional feelings. No tice that the feel ings fol low love. John 3:16 For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that who so ever be liev eth in him should not perish, but have ever last ing life. Gal. 2:20 I am cru ci fied with Christ: nev er the less I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave him self for me. I

John 3:18 My lit tle chil dren, let us not love in word, neither in tongue; but in deed and in truth.

- A. Love requires work. Love does not just hap pen. Gen. 24:67 And Isaac brought her into his mother Sa rah's tent, and took Rebekah, and she be came his wife; and he loved her... Eph. 5:22,25 Wives, sub mit your selves unto your own husbands, as unto the Lord..25 Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ also loved the church, and gave him self for it.
- B. The world's (Holly wood movie and TV) idea of love is lust and not love at all! LOVE is a word which emphasizes GIVE; but LUST emphasizes TAKE. II Tim. 2:2 Flee also youthful lusts: but follow righteous ness, faith, char ity [love], peace, with them that call on the Lord out of a pure heart.
 - 1. Love is eternal and increases, but lust is temporal and decreases. II Samuel 13:4,14-15 And he [Jonadab] said unto him[Amnon], Why art thou, being the king's son, lean from day to day? wilt thou not tell me? And Amnon said unto him, I love Tamar, my brother Absalom's sister...14 Howbeit he [Amnon] would not hear ken unto her [Tamar's] voice: but, be ing stron ger than she, forced her, and lay with her. 15 Then Amnon hated her ex ceedingly; so that the ha tred where with he hated her was greater than the love where with he had loved her. And Amnon said unto her, Arise, be gone. I Cor. 13:8 Charity (love) never faileth...
 - 2. Love covers sins, but lust brags about conquests. Prov. 10:12 Hatred stirreth up strifes: but love covereth all sins. Eph. 2:2-3 Wherein in time past ye walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that now worketh in the chil dren of dis obe dience: 3 Among whom also we all had our con ver sation in times past in the lusts of our flesh, ful fill ing the de sires of the flesh and of the mind; and were by na ture the chil dren of wrath, even as oth ers.
 - 3. Love is spiritual, but lust is physical. Gal. 5:16-17 This I say then, Walk in the Spirit, and ye shall not fulfil the lust of the flesh. 17 For the flesh lusteth against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh: and these are contrary the one to the other: so that ye can not do the things that ye would.
- C. God will never per mit you to be tempted with out providing a way to escape. I Cor. 10:13 There hath no temp ta tion taken you but such as is com mon to man: but God is faithful, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able; but will with the tempta tion also make a way to es cape.
- D. Sex ual de sires are hon our able and proper in mar riage, but you must learn to con trol them or you will be consumed with un godly sex ual lust. I Cor. 9:27 But I keep my body and bring it into sub jec tion: lest that by any means, when I have preached to others, I myself should be a cast away.
- VI. Christ is our ex am ple of per fect love. I John 3:16 Hereby

per ceive we the love of God, be cause he laid down his life for us: and we ought to lay down our lives for the brethren. Psalm 84:1 No good thing will he withhold from them that walk up rightly.
