Witnessing to the New Age and Far-Eastern Mystical Un-Christian Cults

Examine your selves before witnessing to others!!

Wit nessing for Je sus Christ re quires that we (1) tell that we have *repented* (changed our minds) from trusting our selves instead of God and have *faith* (trust) in Je sus Christ to save us from our sins and to rec on cile us to God, and (2) prove by our lives that we have been born again as new crea tures in Je sus Christ.

2 Co rin thi ans 13:5 Exam ine your selves, whether ye be in the faith; prove your own selves. Know ye not your own selves, how that Je sus Christ is in you, ex cept ye be rep ro bates? Acts 20:21 Tes tifying both to the Jews, and also to the Greeks, repen tance to ward God, and faith to ward our Lord Je sus Christ. 1 Pe ter 1:23 Be ing born again, not of cor rupt ible seed, but of incorrupt ible, by the word of God, which liveth and abideth for ever.

What is an Un-Christian cult?

An Un-Christian cult is any group claim ing to be Chris tian which differs sig nificantly in one or more respects as to be lief or practice from those Christian groups which are regarded as the normal expressions of Christian ity in our total culture. Typically, a cult is a group of people gathered about a specific per son or person's mis interpretation of the Bible ans gos pel mes sage.

Galatians 1:7-8...There be some that trou ble you, and would pervert the gos pel of Christ. But though we, or an an gel from heaven, preach any other gos pel unto you than that which we have preached unto you, let him be ac cursed.

Basic Christian theology vs the Cults

Source of au thor ity: the Bi ble, God's Holy Word.

Je sus iden ti fied the to tal ity of God's Word as the ul ti mate guide to the truth that sets a be liever aside unto righ teous ness (sanctifies).

John 17:17 Sanc tify them through thy truth: thy word is truth.

2 Tim o thy 2:15 Study to shew thy self ap proved unto God, a work man that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly di vid ing the word of truth.

The cults usu ally fol low the false teaching of a leader who misinterprets the Bible and/orpresents a new errant prophecy. 2 Pe ter 2:1 But there were false prophets also among the people, even as there shall be false teachers among you, who privily shall bring in dam nable here sies, even denying the Lord that bought them, and bring upon them selves swift de struction.

The God head: a Trin ity of three Per sons in one Be ing. Most cults deny that our Tri une God is One Be ing comprised of the three persons: God the Father, God the Holy Spirit, and God the Son Je sus Christ. But in the Bi ble:

- (1) Jesus identifies the Trinity in the Great Commission given to His churches. Mat thew 28:19 Go ye there fore, and teach all na tions, bap tiz ing them in the name of the Fa ther, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost.
- (2) Paul men tions the per sons of the Trin ity as he de scribes the mys tery of god li ness. 1 Tim o thy 3:16 And with out con troversy great is the mys tery of god li ness: God was man i fest in the flesh, justified in the Spirit, seen of an gels, preached unto the Gentiles, be lieved on in the world, received up into glory.
 - (3) Those denying Jesus is Lordare or dained to condemnation.

Jude 3-4...Ear nestly con tend for the faith which was once de livered unto the saints. For there are cer tain men crept in un awares, who were be fore of old or dained to this con dem nation, un godly men, turn ing the grace of our God into las civi ous ness, and de nying the only Lord God, and our Lord Je sus Christ.

(4) Lasting joy is in the Lord! No cult mem ber will be truly happy nor have peace in his heart un til he knows who Je sus really is and trusts Je sus as Lord and Sav ior. *Philippians 4:4 Rejoice in the Lord al way: and again I say, Rejoice.*

Hu man na ture, sin, and sal va tion: sin en tered hu man ity because of Adam's trans gres sion and all man kind are sin ful in need of sal va tion. Romans 5:12 Where fore, as by one man [Adam] sin en tered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned... 19 For as by one man's [Adam's] dis obe di ence many were made sin ners, so by the obe di ence of one [Je-

sus] shall many be made righ teous. Romans 3:23 For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God... 6:23 For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eter nal life through Je sus Christ our Lord. Salvation: sal vation is all of grace (un mer ited fa vor), both obtained and main tained by God's grace and not by man's works!

Man's good works of faith fol low sal va tion and show that the believer has been born again as a new crea ture in Christ. Ephesians 2:8-10 For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: Not of works, lest any man should boast. For we are his work man ship, cre ated in Christ Je sus unto good works, which God hath be fore or dained that we should walk in them.

All cults vi o late these di rect state ments of God. All cults teach that a per son is saved from God's judg ment of hell by doing some form of good works. Each cult differs in de scrip tion of the good works that s per son must do to earn the right to enter God's heaven, but all cults teach sal va tion by hu man works. Cults may rec og nize that Christ ini ti ates or com pletes the salva tion of a be liever, but the be liever's works are nec es sary to ob tain and main tain this sal va tion.

No cult member has assurance of salvation. Since all cult members be lieve that they are work ing their way to heaven, they have no as surance of sal vation and eter nal life in Christ. The cults all be lieve that spe cific sins will cause a cult member to lose his sal vation and die without hope. Cult members financially support their cults, visit fre quently and wit ness regularly due to their fear of los ing their sal vation if they do not obey their cult leaders. One cult member told Dr. Terrell that he prayed for God to save him every day just in case he had done some thing that day that might have caused him to lose his sal vation. No cult member has the peace and joy that the true be liever's security in Christ provides!

Romans 8:38-39 For I am per suaded, that nei ther death, nor life, nor an gels, nor prin ci pal i ties, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, Nor height, nor depth, nor any other crea ture, shall be able to sep a rate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Je sus our Lord. Ephe sians 1:12-14 That we should be to the praise of his glory, who first trusted in Christ. In whom ye also trusted, af ter that ye heard the word of truth, the gos pel of your sal va tion: in whom also after that ye be lieved, ye were sealed with that holy Spirit of prom ise, Which is the ear nest of our inher itance until the redemption of the pur chased posses sion, unto the praise of his glory.

New Age and Far-Eastern Mystical Un-Christian Cults

Far-Eastern mys ti cal cults in the U.S. are uni fied un der the umbrella term, *New Age*. The New Age Cults are a large, *loosely* structured network of organizations and individuals (e.g., Actress Shirley MacLaine) united by common values based in mysticism and monism (the world view that *all is one*). New Agers have a com mon vi sion of a com ing *new age* of peace and mass enlightenment, the *Age of Aquarius*. This expected *New Age* will ex pand global peace, mass spir i tual enlighten ment and spiri tual advance ment.

The New Age move ment is a collections of cults empha sizing spirituality, health, politics, education, and business seeking to direct the path of society. New Age cults share many be liefs in common, but often hold numerous distinctive doctrines and may disagree with each other on significant is sues.

Source of au thor ity: Far-eastern mysticism (e.g., Hin du ism) blended with Christian terminology and materialism (in dulgence) in stead of Hindu as cet i cism (self-denial).

New Age be liefs are based on the mid-1800 teach ings of Phineas P. Quimby, termed *New Thought* or *Mind Cult*, and the teach ings of Hel ena Petrovna Blavatsky who founded the The os o phy Cult in 1875. Quimby was also a teacher of Mary Baker Eddy, founder of the Christian Scientist Cult.

The Godhead: monism/pantheism, being of inclusive one ness. New Age cults de fine God as one-ism or monism, i.e., as an im per sonal force per vad ing all cre ation such that all is one and one is all. New Agers ar gue that every thing is ultimately God (all-God or pan the ism). This blend of con tra dic tory monism and pan the ism con cludes that there is really no you or me distinction. As in the error of Hin du ism, there is only one big impersonal "I" which in cludes every person and every thing (trees, rocks, an i mals, etc.). How ever, Gen e sis 1 re yeals that God is sep a rate and distinct from His creation. The Bible also re veals that God is an intelligent, compassion ate, and personal Being, the only living and true God. Jere miah 31:3 The LORD hath ap peared of old unto me, say ing, Yea, I have loved thee with an ev er last ing love: there fore with lovingkindness have I drawn thee. 1 John 3:20 ... God is greater than our heart, and knoweth all things. 1 Thessalonians 1:9 ... ye turned to God from idols to

Human na ture, sin, and salvation: Man is really God and sin is an unreal illu sion.

serve the liv ing and true God.

New Agers decide for themselves what is right because they claim to be God who is all in all. Evil/sin are mis di rected thought orig i nat ing in the mind. New Agers save them selves by their works of mental/spiritual enlightenment through learn ing to think cor rectly, i.e., god-realization.

Astrology

Astrology believe the positions and movements of the stars and planets (cosmos) directly in fluence human events

and can be read by ini ti ates to pro vide in for mation for guiding one's life. Astrologers claim that personality and character weak nesses/strengths are affected by as trological move ments. U.S. President and Nancy Reagan (once a follower of occult ist Jeanne Dixon) scheduled activities based on as trologer Joan Quigley's forecasts. Astrology horoscopes are widely published but are observed to be correct less that 10% of the time.

God condemns involvement with fortune tellers such as the astrologers, the stargazers, the monthly prognosticators (Isa iah 47:12–15). God's peo ple must learn not the way of the hea then, and be not dis mayed at the signs of heaven; for the hea then are dis mayed at them (Jere miah 10:2).

Baha'ism

Baha'ism is a non-Christian cult that began in Iran in the nine teenth century with a young religious Iranian business man known as Mir za' Ali Muham mad, who came to be lieve him self to be a di vine man i festation projected into the world of time and space as a *Bab* (Gate) leading to a new era for man kind.

The Baha' cult claims that the religious leaders of the world had forgotten their common origin. Baha'ism claims that Moses, Jesus, Mohammed, Zoroaster, Buddha, Confucius, Krishna, and Lao were equal proph ets, mir ror ing God's glory, mes sen gers bear ing the imprint of the Great Cre ator. In ad di tion, Baha'ism claims that Baha'u'llah, whose name lit erally means the glory of God, is the last great man i fes ta tion of the Di vine Be ing. The fo cus of Baha'ism is of ten pop u lar ized as The One ness of God, The One ness of Re li gion, and the Oneness of Human ity.

Occultism

The New Age meth ods are not new but are forms of Bib lically forbidden ancient occultism (Latin, hidden/secretthings) including astrology, spiritism, palm reading, and witchcraft. New Age occult tools include Ouiji boards, crystals, tarot cards, etc., and are used to gain knowledge that helps them unite with the great One.

New Agers employ numerous occult practices. The follow ing words and phrases serve as warning signs that a particular be lief, practice, or group is in volved with the New Age move ment and in compatible with the Christian faith. These include: monism, pantheism, reincarnation, karma, evolution, personal transformation, unlimited human potential, reality creating, en ergy align ment, energy healing, en ergy focusing, attunement, at-one-ment, enlightenment, inner power, goddess within, mother earth, sensory deprivation, intuitive abilities, near-death experiences, chakras, gurus, Tarot, Kabbalah, pyramids, crystal, power, auras, color balancing, psychic centering, UFOs, extraterrestrials, brotherhood of light, higher con scious ness, cosmic consciousness, the Christ, ascended masters, spirit guides, meditation, yoga, guided imagery, visualization, astral projection, silver cord, inner light, out-of-body experiences, mystics, metaphysical, ho listic healing, therapeutic touch, biofeedback, transpersonal psychology, hypnotherapy, paranormal, parapsychology,

higher self, personal trans for mation, values clarification. Deu ter on omy 8:10-12 There shall not be found among you any one that ...useth div i na tion, or an observer of times, or an enchanter, or a witch. 11 Or a charmer, or a consulter with familiar spirits, or a wiz ard, or a nec roman cer. 12 For all that do these things are an abom i na tion unto the LORD...

Spiritism

Spiritism, or mediumship attempts to communicate with either departed human spirits or other spiritual entities (familiar spirits). *Channeling* is the modern spirit ist practice wherein Ascended Masters (persons who have allegedly died and progressed to higher levels of knowledge) and other departed in dividuals trans mit sup posed truths through a physically embodied per son to help those searching for en light en ment. The channel is the person receiving the spiritist information from either the *higher self* [one's most spiritual part be yond the conscious mind] or a meta physical entity from a spiritual reality.

Al though these spir i tual en ti ties chan neled claim widely different iden ti ties, their teach ings are es sen tially the same: (1) God is all; (2) man is God; (3) man cre ates his own re al ity; (4) death is un real; and (5) the self is where all truth re sides.

Most spirit ist chan nels are prob a bly char la tans trying to make a dishon est dol lar; how ever, a some may partic i pate in voluntary demon possession. God tells His people not to practice divination of any kind (Le viticus 19:26) and forbade them to consult mediums and spiritists (Leviticus 19:31; 20:6; Deuter on omy 18:9–12). God equates as trology to idolatry and commanded Is rael to put to death all sor cer ers, mediums, and spiritists (Ex o dus 22:18; Le viticus 20:27).

Not the stars, but God is our ruler and guide. Spir it ism is the re jec tion of Christ. Isa iah 8:19 And when they shall say unto you, Seek unto them that have fa mil iar spir its, and unto wiz ards that peep, and that mut ter: should not a peo ple seek unto their God? for the liv ing to the dead? Deu ter on omy 18:14-15 For these na tions, which thou shalt pos sess, hear kened unto observers of times, and unto di vin ers: but as for thee, the LORD thy God hath not suffered thee so to do. 15 The LORD thy God will raise up unto thee a Prophet from the midst of thee, of thy breth ren, like unto me; unto him ye shall hear ken.

Transcendental Meditation(TM)

Maharishi Mahesh Yogi was founded TM as a religious exercise or philosophy. TM is a yoga, a spiritual practice of Hindu meditation and asceticism which includes performing specific bodily postures. In the 1970's Maharishi altered his Hindu mys ti cal ter mi nol ogy and pro moted TM in the U.S. as scientifically sound, nonreligious psychological exercise designed to re lieve stress, to bring peace to the in ner man with a positive effect on society, and to enable the advanced practitioner to participate in astral projection (soul leaving the body) and levitation. Most Westerners are unaware of TM's far-eastern Hindu mystical religious presuppositions and nature.

UFOs

New Agers are obsessed with UFOs and extraterrestrial life. New Agers have bor rowed the term *channeling* from

the spirit ism and the early fly ing-saucer move ment of the 1950's when a num ber of peo ple started go ing into trances and let ting the so-called space broth ers talk through them. Numerous *aliens* now be ing chan neled give mes sages very similar to the ones coming from Ascended Masters and other de parted spirits. New Agers claim that the UFO mission is to raise our con scious ness so we can rec og nize our own individual Godhood.

The tone of UFO mes sages and the link they have with New Age oc cult ism in di cates that UFO's are prob a bly demonic in origin. Dr. Terrell has personally interviewed Chris tians who claimed to have sighted UFO's con tain ing aliens. Sa tan seems to be the au thor of this con fu sion which may include hypnosis. A Christian should avoid seeking contact with UFO's, astrologers, witches, palm-readers, etc, since such contact is in viting Sa tan to in flu ence your life. If a per son seeks ad vice from cults that are in flu enced by Sa tan, be as sured that Sa tan will try to in flu ence that person's life to draw him into cultic er ror. **Do not in vite Sa tan to in flu ence your life by dely ing into cultic prac tices!**

John 8:44 Ye are of your fa ther the devil, and the lusts of your fa ther ye will do. He was a mur derer from the be gin ning, and abode not in the truth, be cause there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the fa ther of it. I Pe ter 5:8 Be so ber, be vig i lant; be cause your ad ver sary the devil, as a roar ing lion, walketh about, seek ing whom he may de your.

Rosicrucianism

Rosicrucianism is not an organized religion and is similar to the fraternal fellow ship of Masonic orders. Named after Christian Rosenkreuz (14th or 15th century) and headquartered in Cali for nia, Rosicrucianism is a mystical brother hood providing secret knowledge that will result in supposed self-mastery. Salvation is purification of the mind resulting from multiple reincarnations and spiritual advancements.

Theosophy

The os o phy as a cult sys tem de rives its name from the Greek term *theosophia*, mean ing literally, *di vine wis dom*. The os o phy claims to be a con tem porary pre sentation of a perennial wis dom underlying the world's religions, sciences, and philos o phies.

Actually, Theosophy is a pantheistic form of ancient Gnosticism, which attempts to embrace religious, philosophical, and scientific truth as it is found in all religio-philosophical sources. Thomas Edison, in ventor of the light bulb, was a Theosophist.

A Rus sian woman, Madam Hel ena Blavatsky, founded the Theolophical So ci ety in 1875 claim ing that Theosoply was a type of spiritism. The os o phists claim that *Mahatmas* or *Masters* are highly evolved ex am ples of ad vanced re incar na tions whose dwell ing place is some where in re mote Tibet. Madam Blavatsky claims that she was pos sessed by these di vine be ings who used her ser vices to teach the re-

stored truths of the great re li gions of the world, which have been perverted by mankind. Theosophists claim there are seven planes of pro gres sion through which the re in car nated souls of men must progress on their way to the Theosophists' heaven or Devachan. Theosophy's heaven is acturally the nirvana of Bud dhism, where the absorption of the per son ality or the soul into a type of world soul eventually extinguishes personal identity. Theosophy offers no forgive ness for sinex cept through myriads of reincar nations ever progressing to ward Devachan.

Unification

The Uni fi ca tion Church is one of the best cults at disguis ing its un usual, non tra di tional be liefs from the un suspecting secular world. The Unification Church, founded and led by the self-proclaimed mes siah, Sun Myung Moon, demonstrates the growing trend toward New Age beliefs world wide. The distinctive features of this kind of cult include (1) its habit of conducting business, especially recruiting, under multiple pseudonyms or anony mously; (2) its Westernization of Eastern religious ideas; and (3) its mis interpretations of Scripture to per suade out siders that its Eastern religious orientation is compatible with and, indeed, is the fulfillment of Biblical Christianity. Groups such as the Unification Church are further characterized by wide spread, and force ful psy cho log i cal pres sure on members to con form and re main loyal to the group at all costs. This psy cho log i cal pres sure is present in all the cults, but it more ob vi ous with groups newly arrived in America whose con verts are mainly young peo ple from fam i lies who have had little or no pre vi ous ex po sure to the group.

The Hare Krishnas, Transcendental Meditation, the Church Universal and Tri um phant, and other similar cult groups share many of same features of the Unification Cult, but each has its own unique ex pression of er ror.

Unity School of Christianity

The Unity cult of Lee's Sum mit, Mis souri, of fers prosper ity, peace, and health to all peo ple of all faiths. Unity has no mem ber ship and followers may remain mem bers of their own churches.

Al though Unity is rooted in the early 1800's teach ings of Franz Mesmer, fore run ner of Sigmund Feud. His concept of Mesmerism includes hypnosis, and his teachings initiated the mind-healing cults. Phineas P. Quimby learned of hypnotic Mesmerism and be came wealthy teaching such followers as Mary Baker Eddy, founder of the Christian Science cult. Charles Fill more, founder of the Unity cult in 1891, followed the mind-healing hypnotic concepts of Mesmerism. Fill more also followed the writings of American au thors Ralph Waldo Emerson (1803-1882) and Henry David Thoreau (1817-1862) who taught Transcendentalism, a philos o phy of life stress ing mind-healing and realities transcending (be yond) the world of sense.
